

## F.6 - Special Stories Jesus - Lesson 1 - Jesus chooses his disciples

### INTRODUCTION

Show Talk about our friends. Why is it good to have friends? What do friends do to help each other?

Jesus had twelve special friends who went everywhere with him to learn from him and help him in his work. These special friend were called his disciples.

### STORY:

This is a story from the Bible about how Jesus asked Simon Peter to be his special friend, his disciple. Luke 5:1-11. This short video tells the story very well, but I suggest you might wish to skip the first 1 minute 12 seconds which has a confessional introduction (it was made for church use) and then tells Peters story up to that point.

### GOING DEEPER:

Why did Jesus want to talk to the crowd of people?
