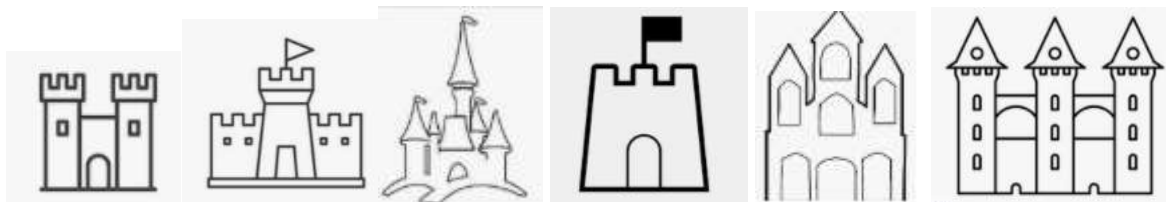
Pop Art is an art movement that emerged in the United Kingdom and the United States during the mid- to late-1950s. The technique is very different to traditions of fine art as it includes imagery from popular and mass culture, such as advertising, comic books and mundane mass-produced objects.

Activity:

Today you are going to draw outlines of castles - simple line drawings - you will do a couple of designs here are some to help you. You can use these for inspiration or copy.



Draw a least 3 different types and keep them safe for next weeks activity. These Castles need to be drawn on a piece of A4 Paper which is folded into 4 so that it has four quarters. The castles then need to be drawn in a quarter of the paper. (So that they are no bigger than that - you will see why next week.)
