

The Creation Story.

LO: To think about the natural world around me and say which my favourite natural place to visit is.

Remind your child that you looked at the Creation story last week - take a look at the table you created last week to remind yourself what was made on each of the days.

These creations are linked to our world today

- Day, night, sky, sun, moon and stars - the world and space
- Land and seas - beach, fields, hills, mountains,
- Birds and seas creatures.
- Land creatures and People.

Have a think about all the lovely natural places you like to visit or learn about.

For example, I love the beach, and during this lockdown I am really missing not being able to go and see the sea, hear the waves, feel the warmth of the sand, have the sand between my toes and find natural treasures on the beach. I also love going for walks in the wood and seeing all the beautiful flowers and signs of spring, especially at this time of year too.

Make a mind map of the natural places or objects you can think of that link to your favourite natural place e.g. for me it would be: sea, sand, shells, seaweed, sea gulls, crabs, pebbles, waves, rocks and rock pools, sea foam, jelly fish, fish - all the natural things linked to the sea. (Adults, you can do the writing for this as the activity is to be creative! Children need to spend their time being creative - not writing.)

Activity

Make a picture of your favourite place - it can be:

- Painted
- Drawn
- print pictures if you have an access to a printer and create a story/pin board with them
- Make a collage using any material you can find - plastic, magazines, newspaper, cardboard wrapping paper, material, tinfoil etc.
- Maybe even use a cardboard box and make a 3D version as a project over the week?

It can be in space, the sea, woods and countryside - anywhere that you find beautiful and fascinating.
