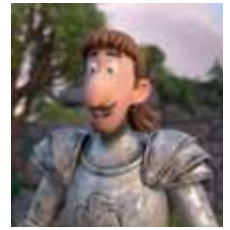


UW - Tuesday 11th May 2021



Materials - Which material is best for a suit of armour?

Activities

With the information you have found - list the materials you can remember - get your adult to write and help you if you can't remember them all.

Go on a material hunt and find an object which is made of each material - Material, plastic, fabric, wool, wood, feathers.

If you can cut a piece off and stick it to the sheet below what does it feel like?

- Soft
- Hard
- Rough
- Smooth

Looking at them, which material do you think would have been used for Sir Gadabout's armour?

Think - it has to be hard to protect him and easy to clean.
