### **Task 1: Read the story - The Four Fantastic Friends (Luke 5.17-22)**

This Bible story is about a man who was so poorly that he couldn't move at all. In this story we are going to call him Ned.

How would you manage to get things done if you couldn't move at all? Life was very difficult for Ned. However, he had four fantastic friends who helped him all the time.

They helped Ned comb his hair, brush his teeth, get dressed every day and helped in any other way they could.

One day the Four Fantastic Friends were very excited. They heard that Jesus was coming to visit a house nearby. Everyone knew that Jesus could make poorly people better. They immediately knew what they should do. They would take Ned to meet Jesus.

They made a stretcher to carry him on. They tied on four pieces of rope, one to each corner. Then they carried him all the way to the house.

When they got there, there was no space, the house was full and the garden was full. How could the four friends get their friend Ned near to Jesus?

One of the friends noticed that the roof was flat, and that there were some stairs leading to the roof. The friends climbed the stairs and made a hole in the roof. They lowered Ned through the hole into the room where Jesus was.
