Make a Mind Map of this to record your thoughts. (The white flashes are lightning and the lights are street lights)</p>
WB 26.04.2 1	God and Creation	<p>The Creation Story. LO: To remember what was created on each day of creation Remind your child what you looked at last week - look at the mind map that you made last week of the things that you saw on the video or if you would like to refresh your memory watch the video clip again. After reading this make a list or use the table attached saying what was created on each day. Draw a picture but you must try and label with words too! WB 10.05.2 1	God and Creation	<p>The Creation Story. LO: To think about the natural world around me and say which my favourite natural place to visit is. Remind your child that you looked at the Creation story last week - take a look at the table you created last week to remind yourself what was made on each of the days. For example, I love the beach, and during this lockdown I am really missing not being able to go and see the sea, hear the waves, feel the warmth of the sand, have the sand between my toes and find natural treasures on the beach. I also love going for walks in the wood and seeing all the beautiful flowers and signs of spring, especially at this time of year too. Make a mind map of the natural places or objects you can think of that link to your favourite natural place e.g. for me it would be: sea, sand, shells, seaweed, sea gulls, crabs, pebbles, waves, rocks and rock pools, sea foam, jelly fish, fish - all the natural things linked to the sea. (Adults, you can do the writing for this as the activity is to be creative! Children need to spend their time being creative - not writing.)</p> <p>Activity Make a picture of your favourite place - it can be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Painted • Drawn • print pictures if you have an access to a printer and create a story/pin board with them • Make a collage using any material you can find - plastic, magazines, newspaper, cardboard wrapping paper, material, tinfoil etc. • Maybe even use a cardboard box and make a 3D version as a project over the week? <p>It can be in space, the sea, woods and countryside - anywhere that you find beautiful and fascinating.</p>
