LO: To change part of a story.



Over the last few weeks we have been learning the story of Snowball. We have been doing lots of activities which involved learning the story and recalling parts of the story.

Today we are going to be changing parts of the story - Reinvent it!

Today Snowball is tumbling and rolling down the hill, but this time he is going to pick up different items.

Using your mind map from Wednesday you are going to make a list of the items he picks up.

I have made a video to show you how to work with your child on their activity. This will be uploaded onto the Dojo class story. I will also message you and attach the activity appropriate for your child.

Remember - your child is on the start of their 'learning to write' journey - when they spell they do so phonetically - this means they will use the sounds they know and hear - they won't be spelt correctly. Obviously some words can be spelt phonetically, however some can't.

For example if they were spelling:

orange - they would spell it **orinj** as they have heard the sounds and used the ones they know.

apple would be **apl/appl**

This is what we want to see - them using their knowledge - not yours as they can become confused as they may not be ready to move onto that level.
