## Dragon Eye Art

In the story of Zog, he is a dragon; we are going to use clay/salt dough (recipe on website) to create our own dragon's eye.

You can make your dragon's eye any shape you like and give it any texture that you like.

### Activity:

Draw a few pictures to help you decide what shape and colour you would like your dragon's eye to be like.

You will need some modelling material and a button/bead for the eye.

Once you have decided on your favourite make the eye using your salt dough/play dough/plasticine/clay/fimo - whichever modelling material you chose to use.

Don't forget to make marks in the material to give it texture. Once you have done this place your eye (bead/button) in the centre to give the eye of the dragon.

Once it has dried paint the rest of the eye.
