Go on a visit to your local library (COVID permitting) Can you find any books about castles, knights or dragons? You might find some story books or information books. What is your favourite? What are these four countries? One of these countries has a dragon on their flag. Which country is this?	Maybe you could visit a castle such as Dunster or go and look at the Castle/museum in Taunton. What can you find out about castles? Ask an adult if they can help you find out a fact.	Make some play dough and make a 3D model of a dragon
