Home-learning 20-21

In light of the situation with Covid-19, we have been reviewing our home-learning expectations for this academic year and would like to share this with you so that you can continue to support your child at home. This information can also be found on your child's class page within the **Home-learning star** icon.

Home-learning will be set on a Friday and children will have until the following Friday to complete the work set. A home-learning book will still be sent home with your child so that they can complete the optional curriculum tasks from the learning grid and to support other activities such as spellings or time-tables that are not on-line. The book will also have your child's passwords to allow them to access the following:

- My-Maths
- TT-Rockstars and Numbots
- Spelling Shed

The emphasis is to ensure that the key reading and mathematical skills are re-enforced as these are crucial to being a successful learner. Children will still also have the opportunity to develop other skills and interests from across the curriculum via the home learning grid that is sent out each half-term. Your help with supporting your child with their reading, learning spellings and times-tables is really important and greatly appreciated.
