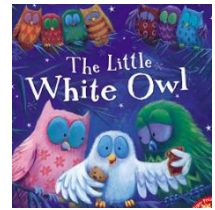

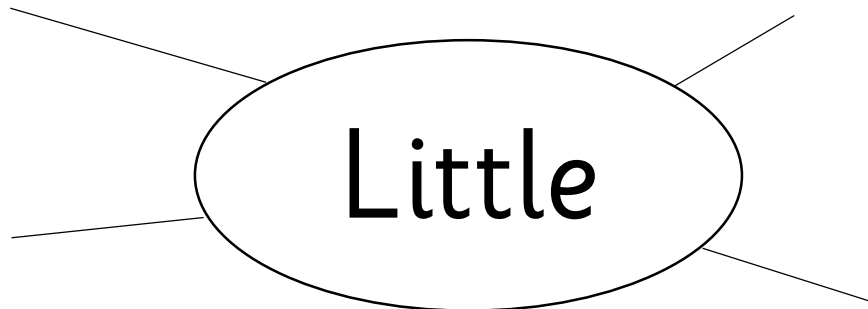
LO: Express our opinions

Starter: Find synonyms.



Synonyms are words or phrases that have exactly the same meaning as the original word e.g. synonyms for **BIG** would be **huge, giant, massive**.

How many different words can you find that mean the same as LITTLE? You might find it useful to use this online thesaurus: <https://www.thesaurus.com/browse/kid>
