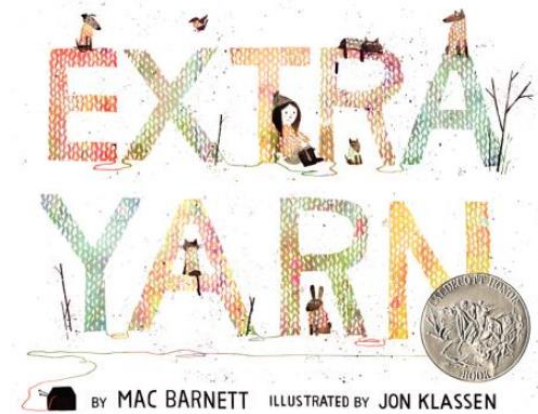


Home Challenges – Otter Class Summer Term One
