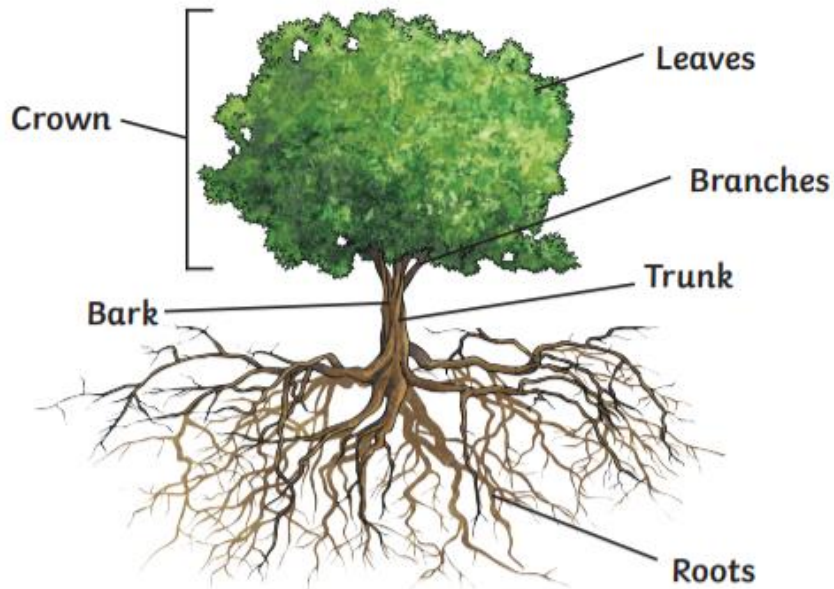


Parts of a Tree



Vocabulary	
deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.
evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in winter.
roots	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground.
trunk	Supports the tree and transports water to the leaves.
leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to help the plant to make its own food.
branches	Helps to transport water to the leaves.

What will I know by the end of the unit?

What is an evergreen tree?	A tree that keeps its leaves all throughout the year. An example is a pine tree.
What is a deciduous tree?	A tree that loses its leaves in autumn. An example is an oak tree.
Name 4 different parts of a tree	roots, truck, leaves, branches
What is the role of the roots?	Roots take up water and nutrients to different parts of the soil.
What is the role of the truck?	Supports the tree and transports water to the leaves.
What is the role of the leaves?	Leaves use light from the sun, along with carbon dioxide from the air and water to make food for the plant.
