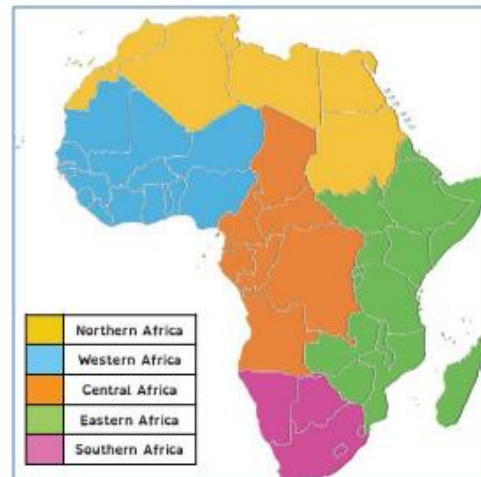


Key Knowledge

Nigeria



Nigeria is a country in western Africa. It has a population of 188,500,000, more than any other country in Africa. Its capital is Abuja. Nigeria is known for being a large country with an area of 923,768 km², and one of the richest in Africa.

Morocco



Morocco is a country in North Africa. It has a population of over 33.8 million and an area of 446,550 km² (172,410 sq mi). Its capital is Rabat, and the largest city is Casablanca.

Central African Republic



The Central African Republic (CAR) is a country in Central Africa. The CAR covers a land area of about 620,000 square kilometres (240,000 sq mi), and has an estimated population of about 4.4 million as of 2008. Bangui is the capital city.

South Africa



South Africa is a country in Southern Africa. It has a n estimated population of 57,725,600 million as of 2018 and covers an area of 1,211,037 km² (471,445 sq mi). Pretoria is the capital city.

Tanzania



Tanzania is a country in East Africa. The official languages are Kiswahili and English. In 2017, there were about 54,000,000 people living in Tanzania, which has an area of 947,303 km² (365,756 sq mi). The capital city is Dodoma.
