

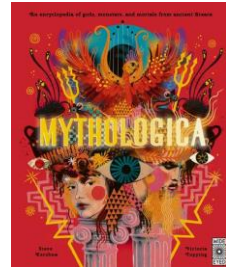
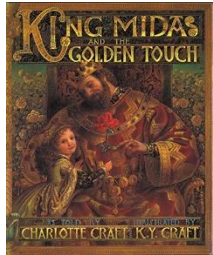

Write a descriptive piece about being in the battle of Marathon or the siege of Troy.	Compare the architecture of the ancient Greeks to modern buildings – are there any similarities? Can you find buildings that have been influenced by Ancient Greek architecture?
Compare the sporting activities of the ancient Olympic games to those of the modern Olympics.	Create your own Ancient Greek shield.	Investigate which animals live in Greece.
