Next half term our question will be:

‘Who were the ancient Greeks ?’

In History we will learn about how the Olympic Games and democracy are examples of **legacies from ancient Greece.**

legacies: Things that have lived on after someone has died or a civilisation or event has ended.

There are many differences between these legacies then and now but there are still some similarities that link the present with the past. Research another legacy of the ancient Greek civilisation and record your findings. Here are some legacies you may like to choose to research:

Architecture

You could research ancient Greek architecture and how that style has been used around the world in buildings since ancient Greek times.

Language

You could research the many parts of speech in the English language that come from ancient Greek and research what they mean.

Learning

Ever since ancient Greek times, philosophers, scientists and mathematicians have influenced the way that people think and understand the world. You could explore one or more examples e.g. Hippocrates, Homer, Archimedes, Pythagoras, Plato, Aristotle, Socrates

Theatre

You could research how the design of theatre buildings has been influenced by the ancient Greeks or you could explore the influence of ancient Greek plays and acting.



You could use the internet or the local library to help you with your research.
