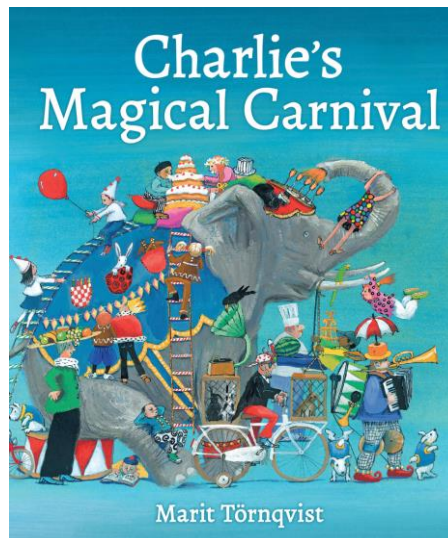


This sheet has been designed by your teacher to introduce you to next term's learning theme.
