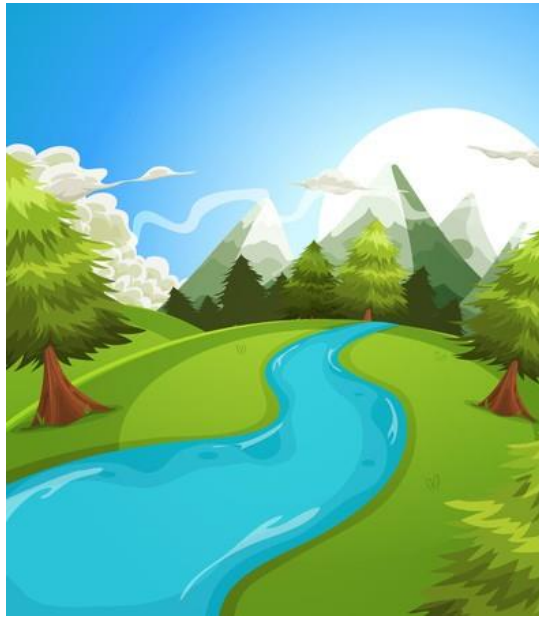


**Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**

Look at this poem. It has been created using a question and then a series of similes.

Roars like an angry lion,

Laps like a cat drinking milk,

Tinkles like porch chimes,
