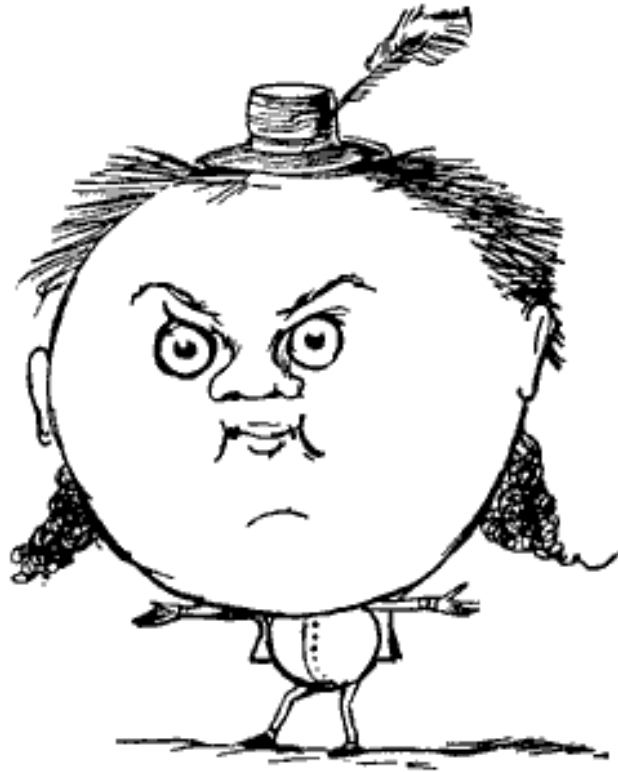
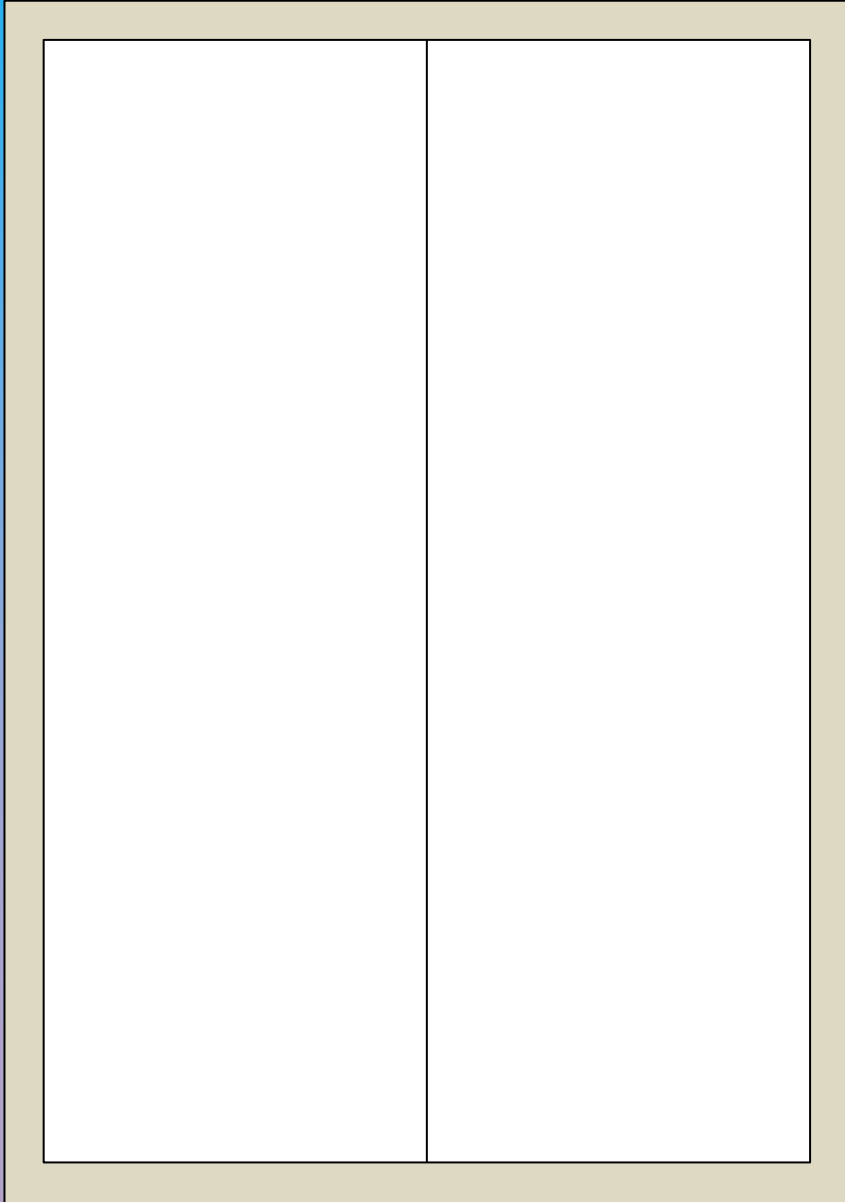


Drawing figures with the

**Task:**

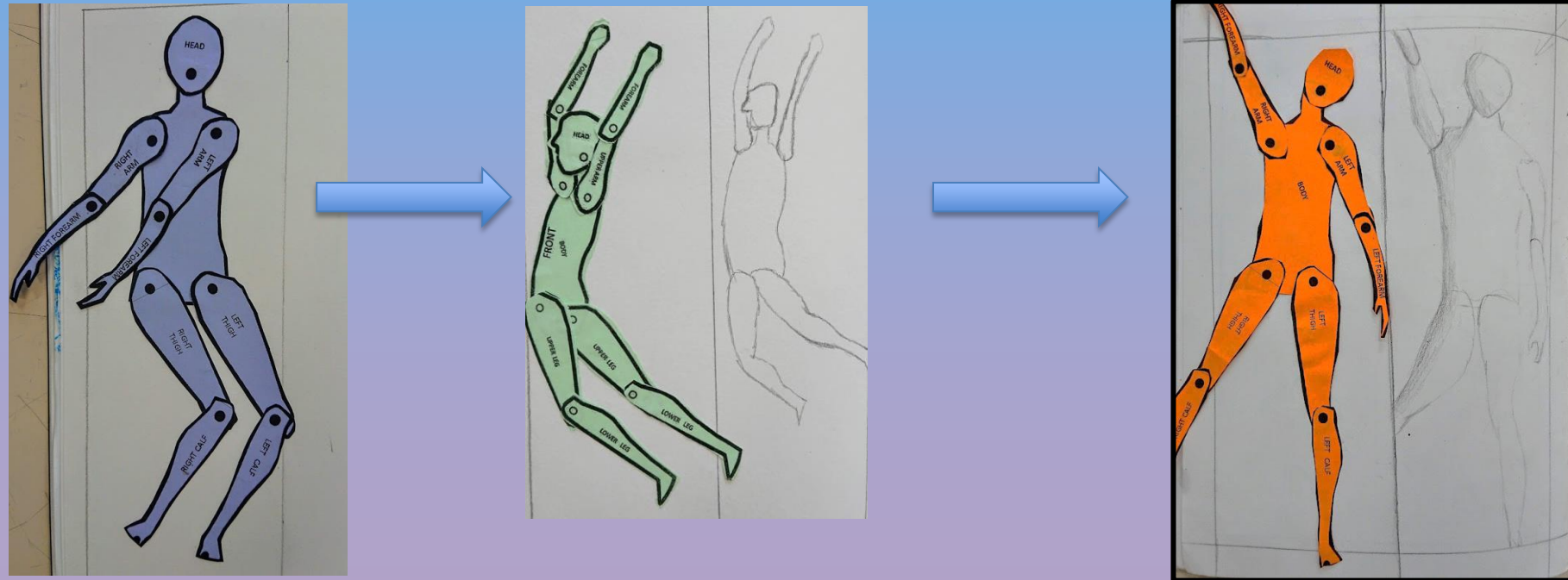
Divide your page in half with a **vertical** line.

## TASK: Use the JOINTED FIGURE to help draw the body correctly.

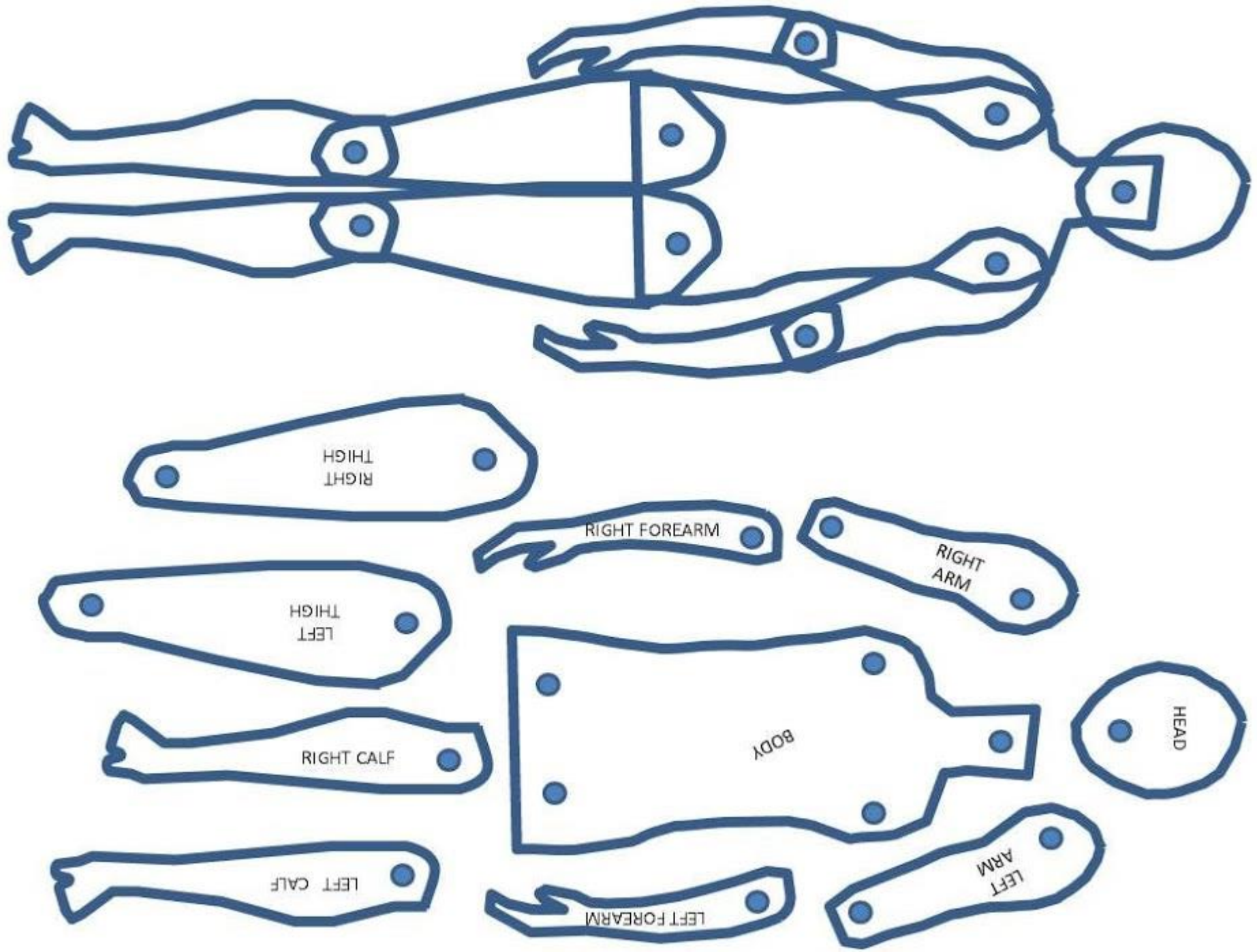
1. Carefully **cut out** the shapes of the body. If you cant print and cut out then you can copy one of the images on this page.
2. Arrange them (the right way around!) on one side of your page and stick them down in a pose that shows **movement**.
3. **Sketch** the figure on the other side of the page, looking carefully at **proportions**. Start with the torso then arms, legs and finally head.

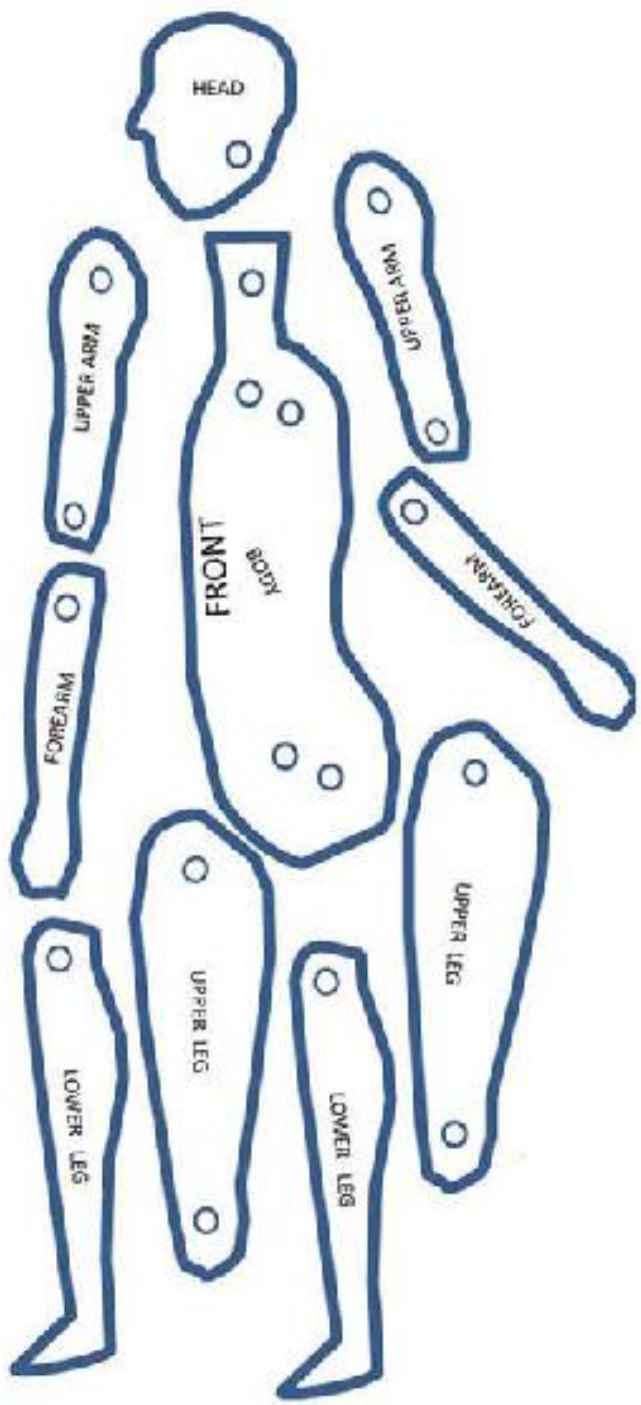
### EXTENSION:

Add shading to make your drawing look 3D. Choose a direction of light and blend smoothly when shading. Aim for 5 tones.
