Read through the PDF on the class website titled 'Holy Week'. The document will take you through the events that happen during Holy Week.

TASK 1

Once you have read the PDF order the events below correctly in your remote learning book. You may cut and stick if you have access to the printer, or write them out in the correct order. You can do a summarised version of each event if you wish.

1. Jesus arrived in Jerusalem. He rode through the streets of the city on a donkey. The crowds waved palm branches and cried out, "Hosanna!" which means, 'save us'
2. Jesus celebrated the feast of Passover with his disciples. This is now known as the Last Supper
3. Jesus was taken to the Roman governor, Pontius Pilate. He was mocked, beaten and had a crown of thorns placed on his head.
4. Jesus visited the Temple, the Jewish holy place. When he arrived, he saw people buying and selling goods. Jesus was angry that people were making money instead of worshipping God.
5. Jesus cried out, "It is finished!" and then died. The sky turned dark.
6. On the third day, some of Jesus' followers visited his tomb. There were no guards and the stone had been rolled away. An angel told them that Jesus had risen
7. Jesus spoke to his followers on the Mount of Olives.
8. Jesus washed his disciples' feet
9. Soldiers, religious leaders and Judas arrived at the Garden of Gethsemane. Judas identified Jesus by kissing him. Jesus was arrested.
10. Jesus was buried in a tomb belonging to a man called Joseph of Arimathea. A heavy stone was placed across the tomb and soldiers stood guard at the entrance.
11. Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray with some of his disciples.

12. Jesus was made to carry a heavy cross through the streets of Jerusalem.
13. Jesus appeared to many of his followers.
14. Jesus was nailed to the cross in-between two thieves.
15. Judas, one of Jesus' disciples, agreed to betray Jesus for 30 pieces of silver.
