

Research about a capital city of your choice and compare it to our capital city, London.	Draw the different stages of the moon each night and see how it changes.
Write a poem about space.	A day on the International Space Station. Write a diary of a day in the life of an astronaut – you might want to find out what life is like beforehand.	Investigate the layers of our planet and present it in an interesting way. 	Draw a bar chart comparing the populations of cities or other features such as climate: amount of rainfall / temperature through the year.
