

Monday 11.01.21 Maths Fluency Answers

Those questions with (M) beside them should be tried mentally. Those with (W) are normally more efficient using a written method.

1) $547 \div 10 = 54.7$ (M) remember the digits move 1 place to the right

2) $547 \div 100 = 5.47$ (M) remember the digits move 2 places to the right

3) $34 \times 7 = 238$ (W)

4) $4 + 9 + 1 + 6 = 20$ (M)

5) $432 \div 7 = 61 \text{ r } 5$ or $61 \frac{5}{7}$ or 61.715 recurring (W)
