

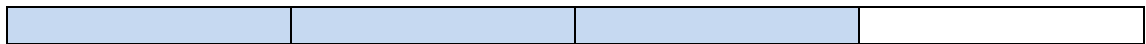
Thursday 02.04.20 Maths Fluency

Those questions with (M) beside them should be tried mentally. Those with (W) are normally more efficient using a written method.

- 1) $\frac{1}{4}$ of 64 = (M/W) 64 divided into 4 groups and you have 1 of them



- 2) $\frac{3}{4}$ of 64 = (M/W) 64 divided into 4 groups and you have 3 of them



- 3) $3422 - 2721 =$ (W)

- 4) $873 \div 7 =$ (W)

- 5) $617 \div 10 =$ (M)

- 6) $617 \div 100 =$ (M)
