

Friday 15.01.21 Maths Fluency - Answers

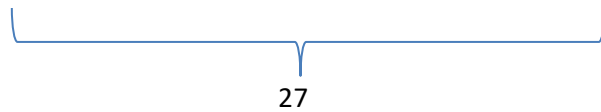
Those questions with (M) beside them should be tried mentally. Those with (W) are normally more efficient using a written method.

1) $1/5$ of 45 = 9 (M/W) $45 \div 5 = 9$

9	9	9	9	9
---	---	---	---	---

2) $3/5$ of 45 = 27 (M/W) $45 \div 5 = 9$ then $9 \times 3 = 27$

3) $999 + 1 = 1000$ $999 + 10 = 1009$ $999 + 100 = 1099$

4) $999 - 1 = 998$ $999 - 10 = 989$ $999 - 100 = 899$

5) $459 \div 6 = 76 \text{ r}3$ $= 76 \frac{3}{6}$ $= 76 \frac{1}{2}$

(W) answer with the remainder as a fraction in its simplest form
