If you do not have paint draw around your hands and cut them out instead.</p> <p>Record: Stick your hands onto paper and bring it in.</p>	<p>Sammy the squirrel collected 3 nuts.</p> <p>Sidney the Squirrel collected 2 nuts.</p> <p>How many nuts did they have altogether?</p> <p>Record: Draw the acorns and to show how many acorns you would have,</p>	<p>Go on an autumn walk and collect leaves, conkers, twigs, fir cones, acorns etc.</p> <p>Make an autumn picture using the natural resources you have collected.</p> <p>Record: Either take a photo of this and upload onto Tapestry or stick it on paper/card and bring it into school.</p>	<p>Go on a walk and take an Autumn selfie with your adult.</p> <p>Record: Upload your photo onto Tapestry.</p>	<p>Draw a picture of the people in your family.</p> <p>Record: Draw your picture and ask your adult to write who the people are.</p>	<p>Animals move in different ways. Move around like different animals and see if your adult can guess what animal you are.</p> <p>Record: Take a photo of you moving around like an animal with the name of the animal written underneath!</p>
