1	$30 \times 70 =$
	


(M/W) 2100

2	$\square + 7,643 = 9,876$
	


(W) 2233 (Use inverse  $9876 - 7643$ )

3	$900 + \square = 1,700$
	

(M) 800

4	$731 \div 8 =$
	

(W) 91 r3 or  $91 \frac{3}{8}$  or 91.375

5	$678 + 400 =$
	

(M/W) 1078 (6 hundreds add 4 hundreds makes 10 hundreds. Tens and ones digits stay the same)
