

**WALT: Develop our vocabulary with synonyms and antonyms**

We will be writing some descriptive pieces and poems later in the week connected to our theme of the sea. Today I would like you to use a thesaurus to help you expand your vocabulary on words that might be used to describe aspects of the oceans.

**Synonym = a word with a similar meaning e.g. small / little / tiny**

**Antonym = a word that has an opposite meaning e.g. big / small**

**Task 1**

Find synonyms and antonyms for each of the following words. If you would like to choose additional words then please do.

Words to look for

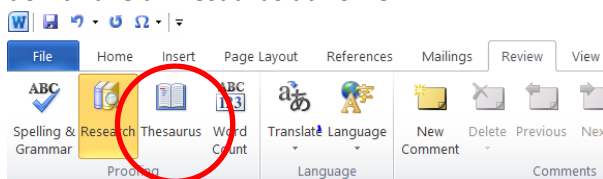
- Calm
- Kind
- Rough
- Angry
- Blue (no need for antonym here)
- Roaring
- Thundering
- Whispering



You could set this out in a table:

Word	Synonym	Antonym
small	Microscopic, Miniscule, minute, tiny, titchy, petite, undersized,	Large, giant, immense, vast, enormous, gigantic, whopping

Tip: You can use the Thesaurus tool in Microsoft Word to help you or search on the internet if you don't have a Thesaurus at home



EXTN:

Can you 'rank' them so that they indicate the size or 'degree'  
e.g. for small (adjective)

Microscopic, Miniscule, minute, tiny, titchy, petite, undersized, small
