

Pre-learning Task: Geography- Summer 1 Term

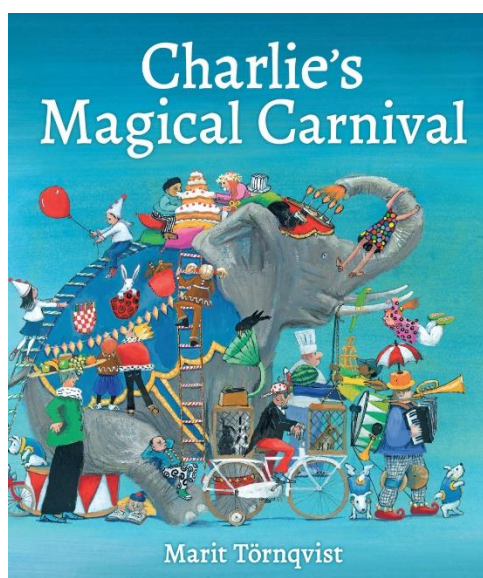
Year 3/4- Key Question: **Are you captivated by a carnival cavalcade?**

- Name some foods we eat that come all the way from the tropical rainforests of Brazil.

- Find out about Somerset carnival. Create a poster advertising Somerset carnival for potential tourists.
- Name/ find 5 native deciduous trees of Britain. Maybe you could draw the leaves or do a rubbing?
- Look at some of Salvador Dali's paintings. Write a mini review of his work for an art webpage.
