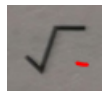


Friday 12.02.21 Maths Fluency

Remember 75% is the same as finding $\frac{3}{4}$ of a number – divide it by 4 and then times by 3



This means the square root of the number (the number you times itself by to get that number e.g. 5×5 is 25 so the square root of 25 is 5).
