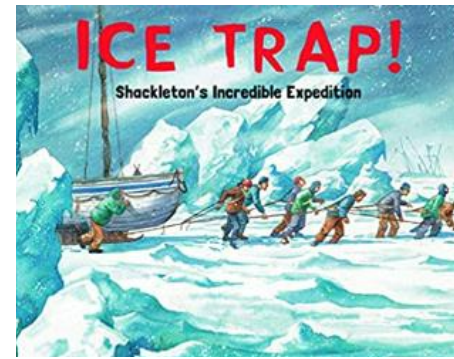


Home Challenges – Otter and Squirrel Class

Find out about how people in the polar regions use dogs.
