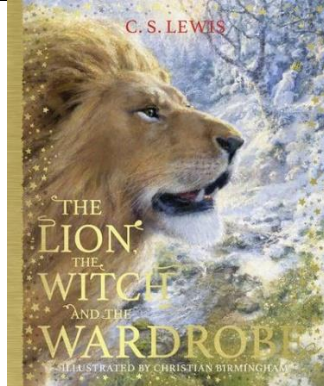

Where do they grow naturally?

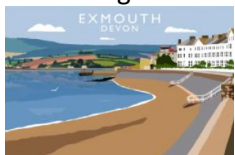
Draw and label your favourite one!
