

Friday 08.01.21 Maths Fluency - Answers

Those questions with (M) beside them should be tried mentally. Those with (W) are normally more efficient using a written method.

1) $34.0 \div 10 = 3.4$ (M) remember the digits move 1 place to the right

2) $34.0 \div 100 = 0.34$ (M) remember the digits move 2 places to the right

3) $4,456 - 3,137 = 1,319$ (W)

4) $6 + 6 + 8 = 20$ (M)

5) $7 \times 56 = 392$ (W/M) $7 \times 50 = 350$ $7 \times 6 = 42$ $350 + 42 = 392$.
