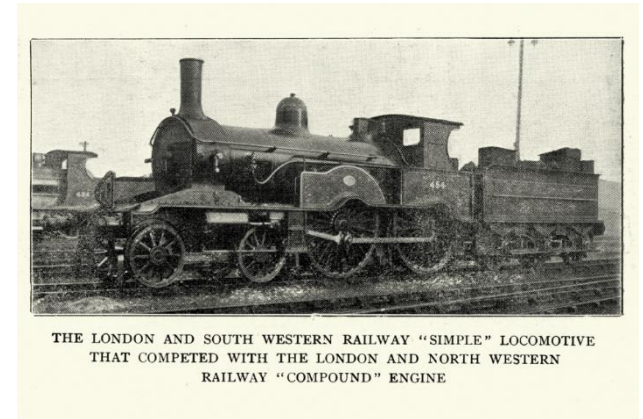
Task 1:
