


Rockets Curriculum Goals



Communication and Language

Engage actively with frequent stories, rhymes and poems. Enjoy listening and are able to remember and recall much of what happens.

Take part in back and forth interactions with adults and peers initiating conversations and extending them.

To share ideas and points of view and to debate with adults and friends using words as well as actions.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

Develop strong warm and supportive relationships with adults.

Be aware of their own emotions, to manage them appropriately and have a positive sense of self.

Be independent and confident in all areas of their play.

Develop a sense of responsibility and membership of a community.

Physical Development

Be happy, healthy and active through the experiences offered.

Explore play and take risks to develop confidence, control, balance and movement.

Learn to become increasingly independent in dressing, undressing and their self-care.

Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.

Collaborate with others to manage large items such as moving large blocks.

Literacy

Develop a love of books, stories, rhymes poems and reading. To be able to share and talk about these with adults.

Develop their phonological awareness of rhyme and letter sounds.

Communicate using meaningful marks and be able to write the first two letters of their name.

Mathematics

Develop a deep understanding of numbers to 5

Begin to develop recognition of number patterns (subitise) without having to count individually.

Link numerals and amounts by showing the right number of objects to match numerals up to 5.

Understanding the World

Develop a love of the Natural environment to care for and respect all living things.

Develop positive attitudes about the differences between people, countries and ways of living.

Enrich and Widen vocabulary around cultural, social, technological and our ecologically diverse world.

Expressive Arts and Design

Develop imagination and creativity using wide and varied resources.

Interpret and appreciate what they hear, respond to and observe through music, song and sounds

Explore a variety of media to express thoughts, ideas feelings and movement.
