No Outsiders (All Different. All Welcome.)

Thank you to the parent/carers who attended one of our parent/carer sessions regarding the No Outsiders resources that we will be using to enhance our Relationship and Health Education from January. The sessions allowed the children and parents to read the books that will be used and to ask questions to understand more. It was wonderful to gain such positive feedback and I believe that adding this to our curriculum will make our inclusivity as a school even stronger. For parent/carers who have missed the previous correspondence please find out more below.

What is 'No Outsiders'?

No Outsiders focuses on developing children's thoughts, ideas and opinions about the world and society we live in with a focus on equality, diversity and the British Values. The approach is through the children having ownership of what is shared within the session with the teachers acting as facilitators and not sharing their own thoughts or opinions. There is no right or wrong answer but there is a rule that what is shared must be respectful. To do this the children are given a stimulus (a photograph, a picture book) and then from this the children are asked questions such as:

- What do you see?
- What are your thoughts?
- What is your opinion? For what reason do you think that?
- Do you agree or disagree?

This approach enables the children to:

- Create and develop their own opinions and point of view
- Have an opportunity to change their opinions and thoughts
- Challenge other peoples' opinions and thoughts in a safe environment
- Develop a greater understanding of equality and the British Values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, and mutual respect and tolerance.

No Outsiders embraces and values that we are all different and that nobody should be left out. It reinforces that we are all welcome and that children are listened to. The exciting aspect of No Outsiders is that it will just further build upon the inclusive culture that our school already has.
