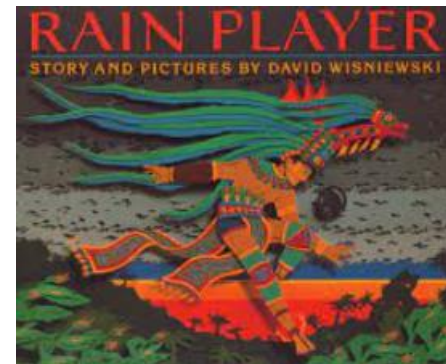


Home Learning Challenges – Tawny Owls and Woodpecker Class

Build a small model of a Mayan temple. You could use Lego or cardboard or clay.

Draw a picture inspired by the Mayan art or create your own Mayan head-dress.

Create a fact-file about a Mayan god of your choice.

Find out where the Mayans lived and draw a map – what was the climate like? What countries are there now? What oceans and seas are nearby?

Research the Mayan number system and create some calculations using their numbers to test the rest of the class.

Create a sundial at home to help you tell the time in the garden.
