Local Authority Free School Meal Holiday Vouchers (information from the LA)

The government's Household Support Fund (HSF) ceases at the end of the month (31 March 2026). It is being replaced by a new fund called the Crisis and Resilience Fund. Holiday food vouchers (known to parents in Somerset as free school meal holiday vouchers) are part of the HSF government package, which means they too will stop from the end of March this year.

Parents who qualified for the vouchers through the HSF scheme already received them during the February half-term holiday, as normal.

However, this was the final voucher provision of its kind under the current HSF scheme. *There will be no holiday food vouchers issued after the 31 March date. This means no vouchers will be available for parents during the Easter holidays, as these fall in April this year.*

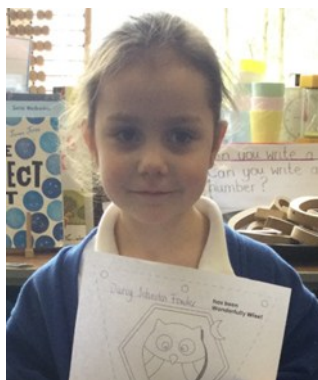
The new Crisis and Resilience Fund will provide access to food support. Any family facing food shortage will be able to secure 'cash-first' support. This is a new service and will be starting shortly with a new provider. As soon as details are available about how and where to access support this will be communicated widely, including through schools.

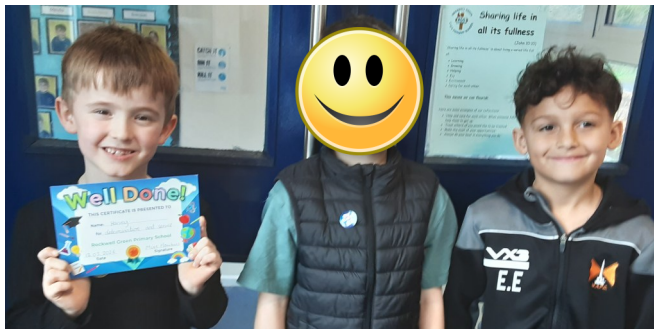

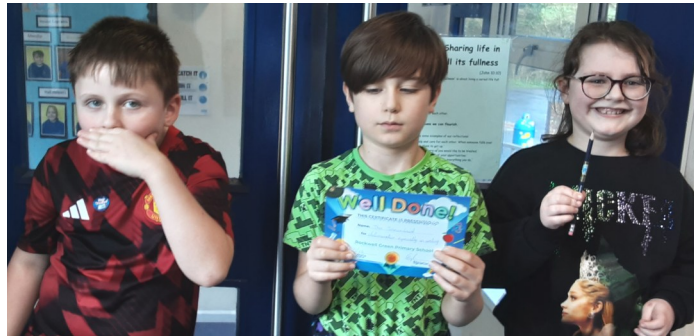
