Local Authority Support

Help is available to households who receive free school meals and are worried about covering the cost of food during the Easter school break (3 April to 19 April 2026).

Somerset Council is working with Citizens Advice (CA) to deliver vouchers from selected supermarkets to eligible families.

The Easter Holiday Family Support service is available online now! Simply complete an application form and provide the relevant supporting evidence.
