Yr1 Phonic Screening

Next Thursday, our Yr1 children will complete their phonic screening. This involves them having to read 40 words where they are expected to read at least 80% of these correctly. We continue to provide daily small group phonic teaching for forty minutes to our children in Reception and Year 1 and those also higher up the school to give them the best opportunity to be successful with their phonics reading. From Year 2 to Year 6 the children then have a daily shared reading session where they read and then comprehend texts as a class. Over the last number of years, our approach to reading has proved to be really successfully and within in phonics our children have been attaining significantly better when compared to those nationally. To support this attainment the constant reading practice both in school and at home makes a significant difference to all children (Reception to Yr6) due to the repetition of skills that the children receive.

Yr4 Multiplication Assessment

Yesterday, our Year 4 children completed the Yr4 Multiplication Assessment. This involves them answering 25 questions with just 6 seconds to answer each one. The questions can be from any of the times tables as the children are expected to know all of the times tables including the 11s and 12s by the end of Yr4. The children who have this knowledge are then able to make greater progress in Yr5 and 6 due to the connections they can make across a range of areas in maths.

The children in Squirrels class approached the assessment with a fantastic attitude and should be really proud of their approach.

Please support your child, if they are in Kingfishers or any of the KS2 classes, to practise their times tables each day. Three minutes a day practise is far more beneficial than a one off 20 minutes as the children are repeating the learning. The children who practise their times tables at home generally make greater progress than the children who do not.
