Any answer that explains the change from:

Relaxed or calm at the beginning / excited in the middle as it soars into the sky / nervous or unsure at the end as it doesn't know where it will be going next

5) 'I wondered where I would end up now' . What will happen to the water droplet now?

Any reasonable prediction based on the idea that the water cycle is continuous:

e.g. It will fall back to earth as rain and then make its way back to the sea by the river.
