EYFS and KS1: 5.15-6.15pm

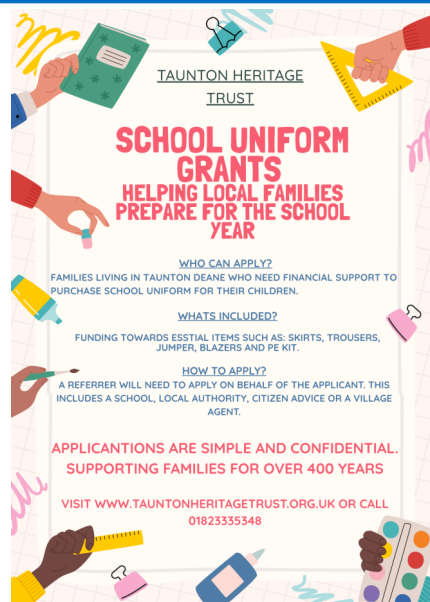
KS2: 6.30pm - 7.30pm

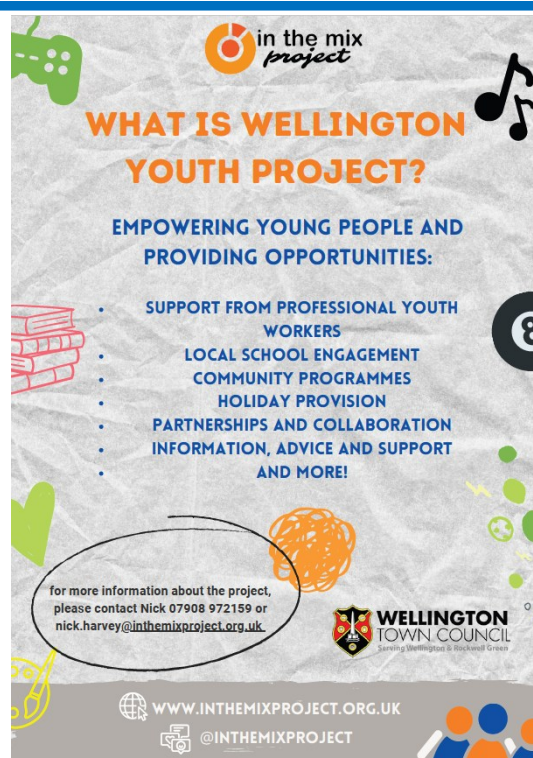

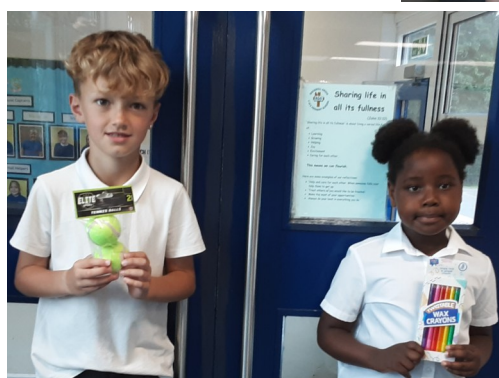
