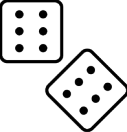
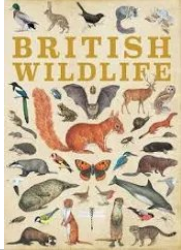


Home Challenges – Otter and Squirrel Class

Autumn Term One – Why are otters and squirrels otterly amazing?

Please note: daily reading is the most important, regular homework and it is essential that your child brings their book and reading record into school every day.

Can you roll three dice and build a create the highest 3 digit number you can with the 3 numbers. Can you then partition the numbers into hundreds, tens and ones. 	Go on a walk and record either through drawing, writing or photographs, all the human and physical features that you see. 	Read an information book or story about British wildlife and write a review about it. 	Draw a map of the UK. Label the countries and the capital cities. Can you label any rivers or woodlands? 	Find out about human or animal skeletons. Draw and label a skeleton and explain how bones help animals move, stay protected and keep their shape. 
Sketch some British wildlife. Take a sketchbook outside and carefully sketch an item of British wildlife that you have looked at carefully. 	Wild word collector – find ten interesting words or ways to describe a British animal, define the word and then write it into a sentence. 	Research English county names. Can you pick one county and find out more about what makes it special. You can choose how to record this. 	Create a wildlife friendly menu. Pick a British wildlife animal and design a menu for them based on what they need to eat. 	Wild Card – Get creative and do something of your choosing that is linked to British wildlife.
