<p>Dinosaur starts with a 'd'. Can you think of any other words which start with a 'd' and write a list. Try and think of and write at least 6</p>	<p>Think of a dinosaur and describe it to a member of your family. Can they guess what dinosaur it is?</p>	<p>If there are 10 dinosaurs in the forest and 4 get lost how many are left?</p> <p>Use your fingers or some toys to help you.</p> <p>Once you have worked this out draw a picture of the dinosaurs and try writing the number equation.</p>	<p>Create your own dinosaur. Draw a picture then write its name underneath. You could ask a grown up to help you write some words to describe this dinosaur.</p> <p>Is it scary or friendly? Is it large, long or scaly?</p>	<p>Take a blanket outside and watch the clouds on a cloudy day. See if you can spot any clouds which look like dinosaurs. Do they have spikes or long tails? You could ask a friend or family member to play with you. Who can spot the most?</p>	<p>Gather some play dough or some empty boxes and create your own dinosaur. You could use a book or a toy to help you build it. You can paint it when you have finished making it - Ask someone to guess what dinosaur it is.</p>
