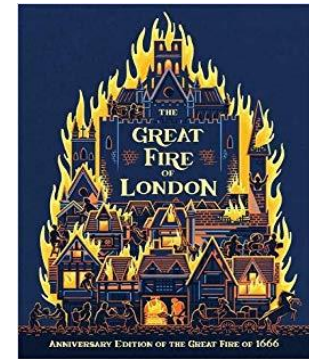


Kingfishers and Hedgehogs Home Challenges – Autumn Term 2

<p>Diary entry</p> <p>Samuel Pepys kept a diary of events during The Great Fire of London. Keep your own diary for a weekend and write about all the things you do.</p>	<p>Shapes and sizes</p> <p>Buildings in London are made up lots of 2D and 3D shapes. Have a look around Wellington, or any other town and find as many different shapes as you can.</p>	<p>The UK</p> <p>What have we learnt from our work about the capital city of England? Carry out some research on one of the other capital cities of the UK: Cardiff, Edinburgh or Belfast – what is special about these places?</p>	<p>Design and Make</p> <p>The Great Fire of London started in a bakery on Pudding Lane. Have a go at baking something you could sell in bakery. Take a picture of the final product or record the instructions you used to show us.</p>	<p>Discussion</p> <p>Get together with everyone within your household and create a fire escape plan. Check the smoke alarms in your homes work and contact the local fire service if you need an alarm fitting.</p>
<p>Present to the class</p> <p>Create a time line of your life so far that includes key events such as the year you were born, the year you started school etc.</p>	<p>Weigh and Measure</p> <p>Find some objects in the kitchen and weigh them- which are the heaviest? Which are the lightest? Are any an equal weight?</p>	<p>Local Area</p> <p>Visit a local bakery. What does a bakery look like today? What do they sell?</p>	<p>Working Together</p> <p>Create a model of 1666 London on fire! Include houses, smoke and flames. You may also include part of the River Thames and The Tower of London in it.</p>	<p>Your choice</p> <p>You have the choice to create a piece of homework based on our topics.</p>
