Please note: daily reading is the most important, regular homework and it is essential that your child brings their book and reading record into school every day.

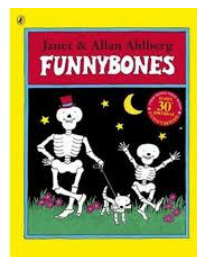
Create a 'count on me' poster that shows the special numbers in your life - e.g. your house number, the number of girls in your family. Can you create any calculations with these special numbers?

Read a book about family or the body with someone and write a review about it.



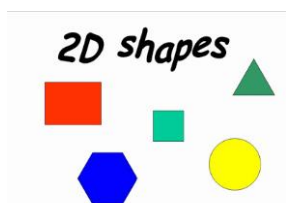
Write down questions to ask an older family member about what changes they have seen. Don't forget to record the answers too.



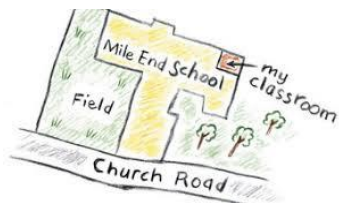
Create a family tree, so we can learn all about the special people in your life.
