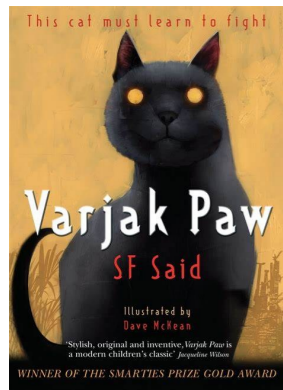

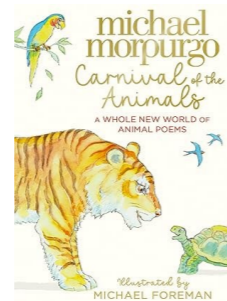

Non-unit fractions:

Pupils can:

- Identify non-unit fractions and the number of equal or unequal parts in a whole
- Use knowledge of non-unit fractions to solve problems
- Place fractions on a number line between 0—1
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator or numerator
- Compare unit and non-unit fractions

Parallel and perpendicular sides in polygons

Pupils can:

- Make compound shapes by joining two polygons in different ways
- Draw polygons on isometric paper
- Draw and identify parallel and perpendicular sides
- Draw shapes with given properties on a range of geometric grids

Time

Pupils can:

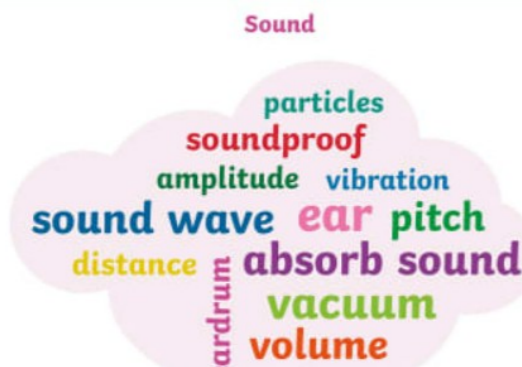
- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks
- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute
- Know the number of seconds in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year
