Column addition:

- Pupils add using column addition
- Pupils add using column addition with regrouping
- Pupils use their knowledge of column addition to solve problems.

2, 4, 8 times tables:

- Pupils represent counting in fours and eights as the 4 and 8 times table
- Pupils use knowledge of the 2, 4 and 8 times table to solve problems.
- Pupils can understand and explain the relationship between multiples of 2,4, and multiples of 8
- Pupils use knowledge of divisibility rules for divisors of 2, 4 and 8 to solve problems
