Architecture

You could research ancient Greek architecture and how that style has been used around the world in buildings since ancient Greek times.

Language

You could research the many parts of speech in the English language that come from ancient Greek and research what they mean.

Learning

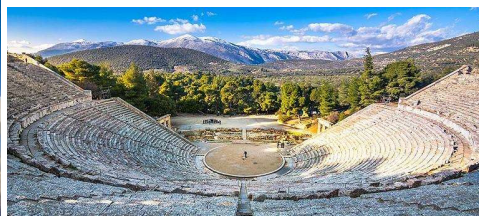
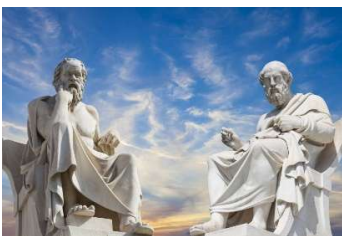

How does our parliamentary system link to the ancient Greeks and how they ran their cities e.g. Athens ?
